Why we do our work:

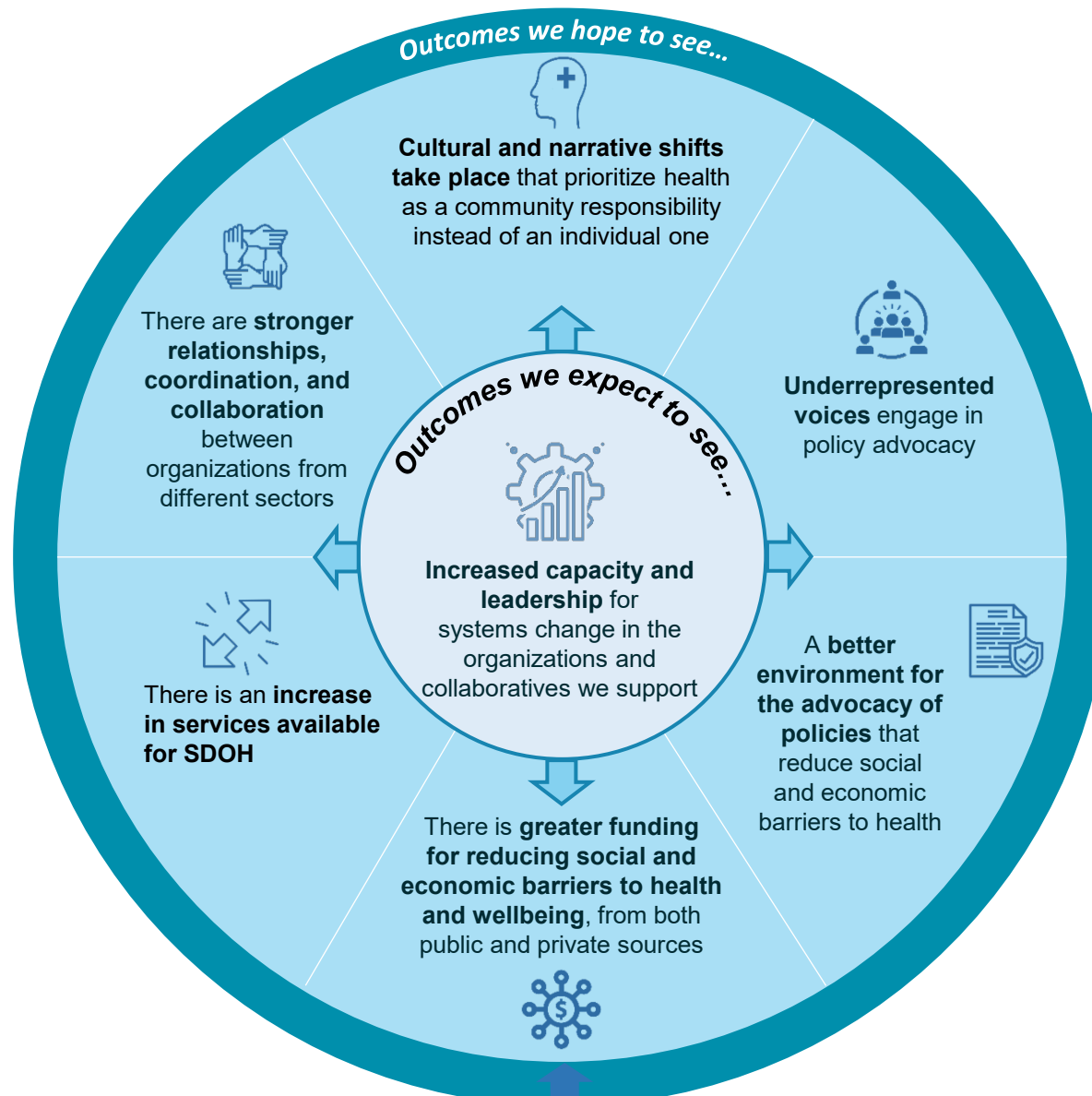
Western Montanans face high social and economic barriers to health and wellbeing, particularly families living in poverty and American Indians.
